OVERVIEW TRADE PACKAGE

The project is set to widen and extend the M4 and M5 by providing 33km of motorway connecting western and southwestern Sydney with the city, Port Botany precinct and Kingsford Smith Airport.

The Works comprise the supply, installation, test & commissioning of the complete Motorway Control Centre building, Pathway & Covered electrical works including:

- Electrical distribution, lighting & small power, Consumer mains
- Generator
- Dimmable lighting
- All Access control items
- Fire Alarm systems
- Preventative Maintenance
- Site investigation
- Liaising with authorities for approval for isolation and relocation
- Power and comms cable
