- Due to the large floor plate,
 Brookfield Multiplex decided to

PROJECT SPECIFICS

- The new Auburn Hospital, which is located in the western suburbs of Sydney, comprises of two main wings with approximately 25,000 m2 of floor space and two central courtyards.
- The facility offers 24-hour emergency care, acute medical and surgical services, maternity services (for low risk births) with antenatal and postnatal services, Paediatrics, allied health and outpatient services.
- The new hospital was built whist keeping the existing hospital operational. At the completion of the new hospital build, the demolition of the old hospital took place and a new car park was built. For its time, the Auburn Hospital development was the largest health project in NSW.
- The project was delivered to the client on budget and ahead of schedule
