- The hospital may request periods of respite from noise and vibration, accordingly, continuity of Work under the contract may be interrupted by requests from hospital representatives.

PROJECT SPECIFICS

- The existing Campbelltown Hospital is an approximately 460 bed major hospital co-located with a mental health in-patient service and is a teaching campus with the collocated University of Western Sydney Clinical School,
 Campbelltown. It provides a range of emergency, medical, surgical, paediatric, maternity, intensive care, renal and other health services to the Macarthur Region of South Western Sydney
- The hospital campus is currently occupied by several interconnected main buildings known as Building A,B,C and D. There are also several small and associated buildings scattered across the hospital site. The existing main entry to the hospital is located between building A and B, while the emergency department and emergency drop off is located at the western end of Building A.
